

The Licking County Department of Animal Control has partnered with Dr. Gonzalez of the Roaming Area Sterilization Clinic at Low cost, better known as RASCAL, to perform low cost cat and dog neuters.

**Registrations**

This must be done in person at the Licking County Animal Shelter. Registrations will be accepted during regular shelter hours Monday – Friday 11:00-4:30 and Saturday 12:00 – 4:00. **Payment must be made at the time of the registration, and is non-refundable.** If your pet becomes ill or goes into heat when scheduled you may reschedule for the next available clinic.
