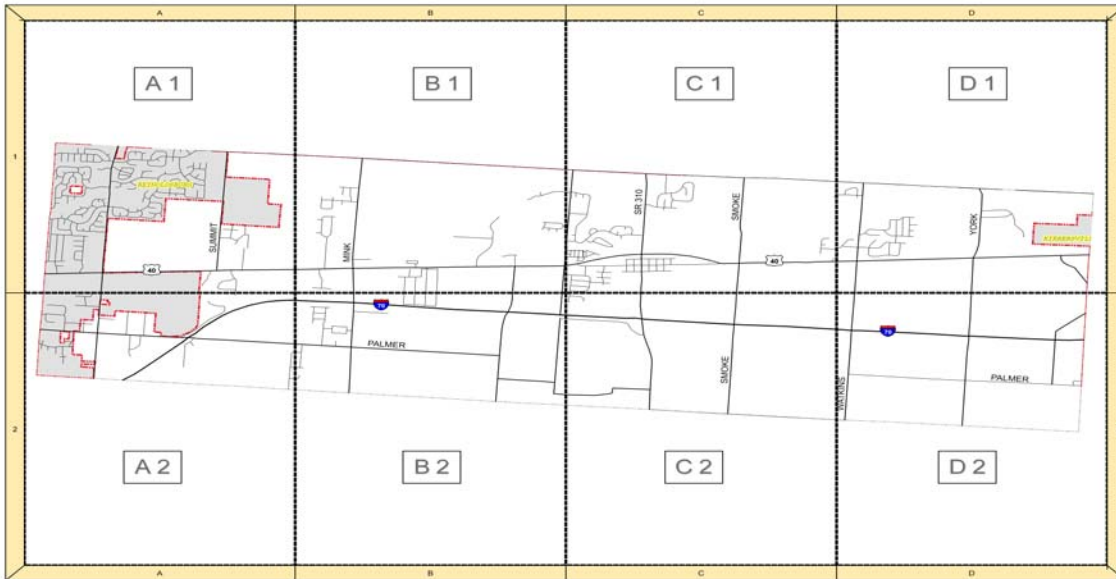

1	Uncertainty the future development. School system is poor.
2	No big Store's close to me like Wal-Mart
3	The area was very nice when we moved there 15 years ago, but growth has taken away what we enjoyed about Etna Township. Traffic has become terrible, and all of the farms that have been converted to housing developments has destroyed the rural feel that we were attracted to. People do not support the school system - I'm guessing because they don't understand the unconstitutional method in which schools obtain funding.

6	School funding; cheaply built housing devalues other properties and adds to school problems; SWLWSD tried to expand too fast and has too little government oversight; property eyesores; too extensive tax abatements given to commercial development.

Anything that gives the township a sense of community we are lacking. 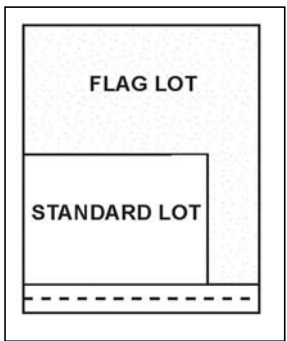

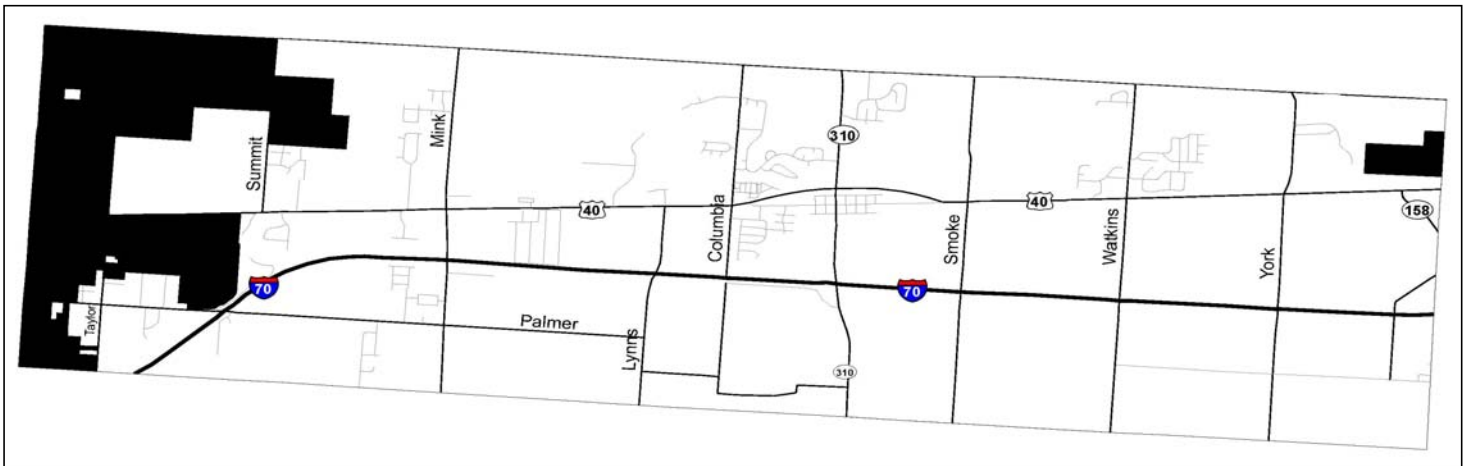
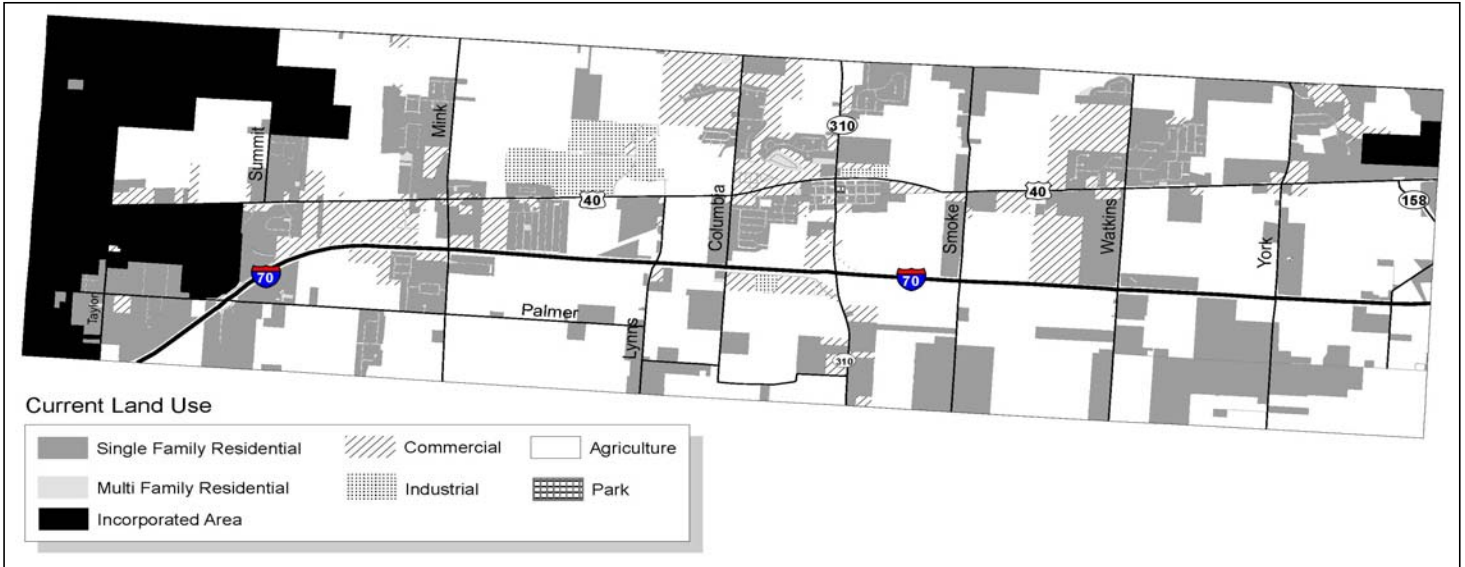
QUESTION #31
