Records Series

Series 1: Miscellaneous Records Found in Courthouse Attic. 1822-1918. 0.24 cubic feet.

Series Scope & Content: The collection consists of records created in various county agencies and by other persons, and found in the Licking County Courthouse attic. The records described in the first thirty listings in the Inventory were found together in a box labeled "Miscellaneous" [sic]. The records described in the thirty-first through thirty-seventh Inventory listings were found with deeds. Some records pre-date the courthouse fires which destroyed many early- and mid-19th century Licking County documents.

Arrangement: Inventory listings 1 through 30 as found in the original box; Inventory listings 31 through 37 by type of record and chronologically
